Program Overview

The Connections program supports the elimination of disparities for youth engaged in school disciplinary measures or the justice system by zeroing in on life-fueling connections and the development of essential life skills.

When youth are connected and presented with opportunity and good choice options, they are less likely to reoffend and more likely to proceed away from discipline and justice engagement.

This innovative, evidence-informed program builds connections for youth to advance themselves towards positive outcomes and life affirming choices.

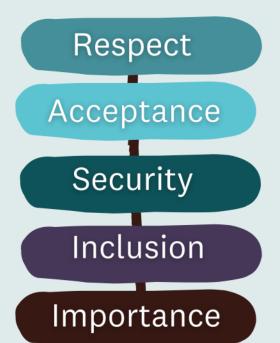
